Dear Parents and Carers,

I informed you recently in our weekly newsletter about changes to the school uniform from September. I am very pleased to say that we are introducing a school tie to our lovely uniform. The tie will be in our School colours of navy blue and pale blue and will be striped in design. These will be available from our School Office from the Monday after our half term break and will cost £4 payable via parentpay.

Children will continue to wear pale blue shirts but polo shirts will no longer be allowed as a proper shirt is needed when wearing a tie. A plain navy blue v-neck jumper or cardigan will be worn; these may be purchased from any shop. The current sweatshirts with the school emblem will no longer form part of our uniform although they may be worn in the colder weather as part of the PE kit. As always, names must be sewn, stuck or written into all items of clothing including your child's PE kit.

The summer uniform of a pale blue and white gingham dress with a navy blue cardigan remains for the girls and the boys are allowed to wear a short sleeve shirt with a tie and short trousers (rather than long) if they wish. Summer uniform may be worn after the Easter break until the October half term.

Shoes must be smart and suitable for school; they can be black or navy. Trainers are not allowed except as part of the PE kit. Children can wear navy blue, black or white socks, girls may wear navy blue or grey tights. Socks must be plain in design with no patterns.

Our PE kit will continue to be navy blue shorts, or tracksuit bottoms in the winter months, and a plain round neck white t-shirt with plimsoles or trainers. As mentioned above, the sweatshirts we have now may be worn with the PE kit during the colder months if you have sweatshirts you wish to get further use from.

Hair accessories must be in school colours only and limited to simple clips and bands. All hair shoulder length and longer must be tied back. Watches may be worn but no other jewellery is allowed, including earrings. Nail varnish is not allowed.

Our aim is to make our children look smart and encourage a pride in our uniform. I know that change can be challenging but hope to count on your support in this new and exciting improvement to our uniform.
