


Our Equality Council

In each of our newsletters we like to share the work that is being completed within our classrooms. This time is the turn of Year 5.. Year 5










To ensure that we keep the learning of our children relevant to them, our Equality Council have surveyed the school to ask what changes they think needs to be made to the curriculum.




Year 3— We liked maths and we like being the youngest in KS2. The teachers are great and reading The Lost Happy Ending in English lessons was great. We really would like to have more time on
